**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON PROPOSED  
4-YEAR INDIAN AREA AGENCY ON AGING AREA PLAN**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Indian Area Agency on Aging (“IAAA”), under state authority through the New Mexico Aging and Long-Term Services Department (“ALTSD”) is proposing a 4-Year Area Plan covering the period of FY 2017-FY 2020, as required by Area Agency on Aging Requirements, NMAC 9.2.6.10(F). IAAA will hold a Public Hearing on August 22, 2016, at 3:30 p.m. in the Sunrise Room, Isleta Resort & Casino Conference Center, 11000 Broadway Blvd SE, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The proposed Area Plan is an obligation as defined within the New Mexico Administrative Code (“Code”), which allows IAAA to receive state general funds under the Code. This Area Plan encompasses IAAA’s vision, mission and guiding principles for New Mexico’s older adults, adults with disabilities and their caregivers. Each of IAAA’s goals, objectives and programs are outlined and articulated within the proposed Area Plan, which ensures that its vision of “*honoring healthy aging*” continues throughout the next four years.
