# Travel Information

## **Driving Directions from northern New Mexico:**

Take I-25 south to Albuquerque. Continue on I-25 to the Lomas Exit (Exit 225). Turn right on Lomas. Go 1 block and turn right onto Woodward Place. The hotel will be on the right hand side.

## **Driving Directions from southern New Mexico:**

Take I-25 north to Albuquerque. Continue on I-25 to the Lomas Exit (Exit 225). Turn left on Lomas. Go 1 block and turn right onto Woodward Place. The hotel will be on the right hand side.

## **Driving Directions from eastern New Mexico:**

Take I-40 West to Albuquerque. Continue on I-40 west to I-25. Go South to Martin Luther King Jr. Ave (Exit 225). Turn left on Martin Luther King Jr. Ave. Make a left on the Access Road to Lomas. Turn left on Lomas. Go 2 blocks and turn right on Woodward Place. The hotel will be on the right hand side.

## **Driving Directions from western New Mexico**

Take I-40 East to Albuquerque. Continue on I-40 to I-25 South to Martin Luther King Jr. Ave (Exit 225). Turn left on Martin Luther King Jr. Ave. Make a left on the Access Road to Lomas. Turn left on Lomas. Go 2 blocks and turn right on Woodward Place. The hotel will be on the right hand side.

## Did You Know?

- ◆ 89% of hungry households have an annual income of less than \$20,000
- ◆ 61% choose between paying for utilities or buying food;
- ◆ 75% report purchasing inexpensive, unhealthy food as the most common way to have at least some food at home to eat;
- ◆ A *Missing Meals* study revealed that low-income people in our state miss 117,140,870 meals per year; and
- ◆ 70,000 New Mexicans are seeking food-assistance every week.
